Our Skate-A-Thon is a fun activity for skaters of all ages, with each participant reaching for their personal best. Skaters set realistic lap goals based on skill levels. Tally counters will be provided.

Our goal is to raise at least **\$2,000.00** to fund **Campbell County Builds**. All money raised for Campbell County Builds stays in Campbell County and goes directly to the cost of materials for building a new home.

We hope that at least 20 skaters will participate in the skate-a-thon. If each skater or skate team raises **\$100.00**, we will achieve our goal. The more contributions you raise, the more we can build! Thank you very much for your participation.

Skate-A-Thon Rules

1. Skaters may start collecting pledges starting January 1, 2022. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be turned in on skate-a-thon day, Thursday, March 17.**
2. Pledges may be made by anyone.
3. **Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, phone number, pledge per lap, or base pledge.** Skaters may collect the base pledge in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected.
4. On skate-a-thon day, each participant will skate from 6:00 p.m. until at least 7:30 p.m. Each participant would need or wants to keep track of completed laps will be issued a tally counter which they will click each time they complete one full lap, thereby keeping track of the number of laps completed.
5. Upon completion of the skate-a-thon, skaters will hand in their tally counters. A volunteer will record each skater's lap total on their pledge sheet and return it. Skaters may then collect outstanding pledges. **Please return pledge sheets with money to Energy Capital Habitat for Humanity by Friday, April 1: either to P.O. Box 3633 Gillette WY 82717 or at our offices inside First National Bank (downtown Gillette).**

7. The skate-a-thon will be open to the public to cheer our skaters on. Admission is free for participating skaters. Skate rentals are \$3 for quad skates, \$5 for inline skates.
